



Tech inspection and check in will be open from 6 to 8PM on Thursday the 23rd and 8AM to Noon on Friday the 24th.

Checklist of must have items on site during registration.

- ☐ Current Valid Driver's License of the person who will be racing the vehicle
- ☐ Current Vehicle Registration and License Plates for race vehicle
- ☐ Current Proof of Insurance listing the race vehicle by year, make, model, VIN
- ☐ Current Valid Competition License (if required for the e.t. your car will run)
- ☐ Working headlights
- ☐ Working taillights
- ☐ Working brake lights
- ☐ Working turn signals
- ☐ Working horn
- ☐ Helmet and any other safety gear as required by the NHRA rules

Welcome to Heads Up Hustle! PLEASE READ, NOTE, AND BE PREPARED TO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- Racers arriving Thursday July 23rd may park their tow vehicle inside the track overnight.
- TECH AND CHECK IN: Tech and Check-in at Dragway 42 is from 6PM to 8PM on Thursday the 23rd and 8AM to Noon on Friday July 24th. These two times are the only times you can tech and check-in. You are required to be present and be IN the tech inspection line at the track NO LATER THAN NOON on Friday in order to compete.
- NO late registration or check in will take place for any vehicle not in line by noon EDT on Friday, July 24th.
- If you are pulling a trailer behind your race car during the event, the trailer must go through tech check-in.
- Note, at check-in, you must present your current and valid driver's license, current and valid vehicle registration, and proof of insurance (all current and in good standing). Your drivers license and registration must be originals not copies, and they MUST be presented at tech check-in. As a reminder, no dealer plates or rental cars are allowed. You will be required to sign a Media General Release and Liability Waiver in order to participate.
- Any drivers who are legally licensed in their state, and at least 16 but under age 18, must be accompanied by at least one parent or guardian. The track's minor waiver must be signed by a parent or guardian.
- Passengers riding IN your vehicle with you between tracks and into the pits at the track will be issued a wristband during tech check-in. Your passengers will need to be present during tech check-in in order to obtain their wristbands and sign the Media and General Liability Release. All minors under 18 must be accompanied by their custodial parent or guardian, and both must sign all agreements and waivers together.
- Racers are responsible to know and comply with the NHRA/IHRA safety rules for the speeds and E.T.s they run. Please refer to: nhraracer.com or [IHRA Rules](#)
- In addition to a current government license, an NHRA, IHRA, or WDRA Competition license is required at registration if your vehicle will run 9.99 or quicker and 135 mph and faster.

- We will provide your racer number and class decal at tech.

- Although the route is not mandatory, we highly recommend that you follow it for the duration of the event. Checkpoints are mandatory to remain in competition. You must take a picture of your car at each checkpoint and have that available for verification the next day at the track. The route info is at headsuphustle.com/route
- The mandatory checkpoints are Twist & Shout, The National Museum of the Great Lakes, and Mountain Machine on Friday, and Marblehead Lighthouse and Big3Racing on Saturday.
- On Sunday for eliminations, each car will get one shakedown pass as soon as the track goes hot before eliminations start. Each class will then be called to the lanes for eliminations. If you miss your class call for eliminations, you will automatically be eliminated.
- Racers must bring their track provided ET slip to the designated location for official recording on both Friday and Saturday during qualifications. You will pick up your time slip from the ET shack, but Heads Up Hustle time slip turn-in will typically be at the Heads Up Hustle tent.
- Racers will not be held at the track and can leave any time they wish after handing their ET slip to Heads Up Hustle officials to be recorded.
- Qualifying sheets will be updated on the website each day at headsuphustle.com/results

- NO SUPPORT VEHICLES ALLOWED.
- KNOW THE RULES. Each competitor is responsible for knowing the Heads Up Hustle rules of this event. Please visit headsuphustle.com/rules for the rules document. It is advisable to download the document and keep it with you.
- You may protest another racer for a rules infraction, however you must follow the proper procedures in the even rules.
